It's important to dress according to the weather.




Upon arrival, I'll check in at the designated station and wait for the walk to start at 9 a.m.




Before the walk, there will be a few announcements over a microphone.

I can step aside to observe them more closely.



The walk route includes the indoor/outdoor giraffe viewing, but if I prefer, I can walk around it.



If I need a break, the Wolfe Lodge offers a Sensory Area/Quiet Zone.



Along the route, some people may be quietly cheering and waving blue ribbon wands with bells.



At the finish line, there will be people cheering and finisher ribbons handed out.



The celebration includes water, fruit, and calming activities.

An ASL interpreter will be present alongside soft music.
