Who Will Be the 3 Millionth Lights Visitor?

Toledo, Ohio—Since 1986, The Toledo Zoo's *Lights Before Christmas* has been a centerpiece of this region's holiday experience, with millions of people enjoying the sights and sounds of the season. *The Lights Before Christmas* will soon reach another important milestone—the three millionth visitor since the event's inception is expected to walk through the gates sometime soon!

The lucky three millionth visitor will be welcomed at the gates with an exciting gift package that includes prizes from The Toledo Zoo's North Star Trading Post® and KeyBank, who has been a presenting sponsor for *The Lights Before Christmas* since its inception. The Zoo celebrated its two millionth visitor to *The Lights Before Christmas* in 2002.

The Toledo Zoo's *Lights Before Christmas* is open through December 31 (*closed Christmas Eve and Christmas Day*). Hours are Monday through Thursday from 5 p.m. to 8 p.m. (the park closes at 9 p.m.) and Friday through Sunday from 5 p.m. to 9 p.m. (the park closes at 10 p.m.). Admission prices are \$10 for adults, \$7 for children (2-11) and seniors (60+), and *free* for children under age 2. Toledo Zoo members receive one free visit to *Lights Before Christmas*.

The Toledo Zoo is open from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. daily (10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Christmas Eve Day) and is located on the Anthony Wayne Trail (US 25), four miles south of downtown Toledo. ID showing proof of residency is required.
